It is much like when we dance, so similar are the sensations, realizations and reverie. As we are in wintertime in the northern hemisphere right now, we can dream. We can dream dance in this way to excavate the parts of us that have gotten lost or covered over, to the parts of ourselves we have left behind - and in this way, carefully breathe life back into the parts of us that have gotten trampled shut. We can dream dance to gently nourish the parts of us that are hurting - to invite the lightness in, to allow the love in, knitting ourselves back together, reminding ourselves that we are whole. Sunset and Sunrise Chantings at the Cave of Clay, on the Moray Firth in Scotland

For many, many years the people of the House of Mica have organised the December Solstice Chanting for the Peace Chamber Communities Worldwide, setting a theme each year.

This year the theme was:

'At the beginning of time, my soul chose to incarnate to be a chanter for peace at this particular moment in time. It is my soul's calling, part of my purpose for being. It is hard and I may feel weary or hopeless, but despite that, I step up with courage and persistence to play my part in this cosmic unfolding.'

The Cave of Clay chamber chose two chanting hours from the 2023 Solstice Chanting Schedule.

This year it happened that the Sunset in the north of Scotland on December 21st would occur during the opening hour of the 24-hour chant, 3-4 p.m. GMT and this was the first slot.

In this hour, within the remit that was suggested, the focus of the chanting was to honour the year just ending, and, while chanting, to recall the events of 2023, both personal and worldwide, and to give thanks to them. Beauty and Horror were present, and the hour was emotional.

Dah-Vii, the Spirit of the Sound Peace Chambers, who journeys round the globe to help us to bring the 5th World into its highest potential, came to listen to the chanting. As he listened, he stood looking down into the central pit which is the connection to Mother Earth, and I wept silent tears. Did I do enough? Do I do enough? The task seems overwhelming and maybe I let *Dah-Vii* down.

The next day, the chamber's chanting hour was 10-11 a.m. Although the official Sunrise would be around forty minutes earlier, during the chosen hour the Sun would be seen rising above the high ground and the tall forest and would send rays of sunlight into the chamber. This had to be imagined this year as thick cloud shrouded the area.

In this hour, the focus would be to honour the coming year, 2024. During the chanting, a group of words came into my mind, 'Love', 'Living', 'Life'. From being separate words, they became a chant and then they became a song. The song-chant played with them; they fell apart, they reconfigured and somewhere, somehow, they became attached to other bits of wording, then loving, laughing, alive and thrive, lively, leaping, lovely, lives, lifting, sifting, shifting and many, many more variations joined the song; really joyful!

Inspired by the chant that Rick recorded, the idea came that the initial letters of the war-torn areas, P, I, and U, R, would form the first 4 letters of the word PURITY and the following T and Y would represent Time and the Ceremonies of Peace which will bring the conflicts to an end. After chanting PURITY, I felt it would be beneficial in the new year to continue chanting PURITY in the chamber with this intent.

During the Solstice Chanting hours, the knowing of what people can do to other people, particularly in war, was unbearable, but, in a moment of silence during the Sunrise chanting, I experienced a shift and felt a call to focus more intently in the Cave of Clay chanting in the coming year on our collective human responsibility for what is happening to Life on our Mother the Earth.

"In 1983 I had a vision, a vision to create chanting places for different people and, in that vision, I was told exactly what chanting was. And I was told in that vision that the original chant was what created the here and now. Present orientation was created by chant, the original chant, and so when we chant, we can go back to our originality, we can go back to our origins, and when we go back to our origins, we can see the potential possibility that was there and that is still there. By going back to it, we can enhance what we do here, in the here and now, because it would be pure understanding and it will not be manipulated thought, but it will be pure essence.

And so, through chanting we can go to the pure essence that created the first resonating vibration of everything that we call 'form' here, in other words we go back to formlessness and to that place where everything first started. We can get to this place by becoming childlike, by becoming teachable."


More than 100 Sound Chambers for Peace have been built around the world, the war gods were taken home by



Singing the Song of Singing Bowl

text from a recording by Joseph Rael referenced in his book, Sound, Native Teachings and Visionary Art Joseph is talking about his life as a boy in Picuris Pueblo, the home of his father's Tiwa speaking people.

"..... as we grew older, maybe when we were 7, 8, 9 years old, we'd begin to learn how to chant. And the way they taught us to chant was that they would pick a bowl full of water and they would say, "Sing that bowl a song." And they would say for us to allow ourselves to enter into the vibration of the water and of the bowl and that the water and the bowl then would intuitively give us the song that it was singing to God.



By chanting the vibration of the water in the bowl and the bowl itself and the ground, those combinations, would give us the resonating vibration in the way that ceremonial bowl could be used to enhance Ceremony. The bowl actually would tell us how water might be used in that particular Ceremony because the vibrations of the water would represent ... infinite light of the universal intelligence of light, and the bowl was the symbol of time and timelessness, and the earth was the vibration of all of the eternities holding the principle of time and timelessness inside of the continuum of light which was the water in the bowl, out of that would come a Ceremony and the chanting that was taking place by say, one elder, two elders, or say, a child, singing to the bowl, the actual singing would then begin to communicate the next steps that were to occur naturally in the ceremonial context and in doing these Ceremonies the village was reinforced not only mentally but also emotionally, spiritually and physically."

"These Ceremonies then were held in order to keep the bond between all of the People. The People as I use it in *Being and Vibration* means 'vibration'. So, the villagers wanted to keep this vibration not only among themselves, the humans, but also, they wanted to keep a bond with the plants and the trees, and the rivers and the oceans and all things on the planet because they were integral parts of being inside of the understanding of what we know today as the Medicine Wheel."

Teachings from my Father on the Vibration of "Weh-leh", to Inspire our Dancing in 2024 from Vision Dance Guardian, Geraldine Rael, Eldest Daughter of Joseph Rael

Happy New Year everyone! My wish is that everyone is well and happy.

We are now in the year, 2024. Using numerology, these digits break down to 2+0+2+4 = 8. Using my father's Picuris teachings, the spirit in the number of 8 is, "wheh-leh."

The Tiwa word, "wheh-leh" means 'to fall' or 'to lie down'. My father says, "At some point, everything has to lie down." He says, "So, in fact, we lie down to rest because inspiration is also saying we have to fall into the foundation of life." He says, "The sheep is the symbol of foundation. When we put the hide of a sheep on anything and we sit on it, we are sitting on the foundation of life. When we do our sheep dance at the Picuris Pueblo it is to honor the foundation of life. The sheep is the metaphor, it is a symbol, it is the sacredness of foundations."


He goes on to reiterate, "Wheh-leh is to fall. Remember I said we need to do the things we were taught not to do. We have to embrace the very things we were taught to avoid. We were taught not to fall, to avoid falling. Now, at the point of wheh-leh, we must embrace the fall. Otherwise, we can't complete the creation."

What I will offer for our Beautiful Painted Arrow Vision Dances in this year of 2024 is this: In our lives when we fall, we get up. From falling and getting up comes INSPIRATION. Why? Because we are more apt to appreciate.

My father says, "I have now grasped. I now know."

The Metaphoric Mind, a Teaching from Joseph Rael

Sound, Native Teachings and Visionary Art, by Joseph Rael (p.160) and Being and Vibration, published in 1993 (p.142)

"God is in everything. As we work with metaphor we discover the connections among all things; we enter the No-mind, God's mind. We become poets and artists, composers, seeing everything through the poetic, artistic, musical mind. We see things from metaphor and are filled with awe. At that moment we are coming from a base of love rather than a base of fear, because fear is an attribute of the rational thinking mind. Through metaphor we can go beyond the rational, to enter the all-loving, all-pervading mind of God.

Our rational, thinking mind does not disappear. It is fused with the metaphoric mind, the mind of God. In the metaphoric mind, there is righteousness based in love. The metaphoric mind swallows up the fear-based thinking mind.

Now, our souls no longer hunger for peace and solitude because at every moment the soul is being fed from this place of love. No longer are we stuck on the surface of the material, but we have gone through the material to reach its essence. Our souls are drinking the light of the essence of the material plane. The loving mind of God has swallowed the thinking mind, owned it and swallowed it into the larger mind. At that moment all there is is love.

Everything that is perceivable to us is now showing us how God is kissing all forms into life, through breath, matter, and movement. God gives sustenance to life.

In other words, metaphor is how God insists upon inspiring our innate God-given gifts - gifts we received at birth – into fully awakened states so that we may materialize them throughout our living moments.

In order to become people full of awe for life, we enter, through metaphor, into ceremonies of the living spirit."



Mother Earth and Mother Nature, Working with the Red Road Cards

insights through chanting from Stella Longland

It was the first chanting of the New Year in the Cave of Clay Chamber. In our meetings we often work with the pack of 20 Red Road cards, introducing them in various ways as we work with the Medicine Wheel that is embodied in the structure of the Chamber building, receiving inspiration from them and, with their help, creating living metaphors for the benefit of this 5th World of *Pah-nu*.

"Pah-nu - 5 - Crystallizing light ~ Pah is the light of universal intelligence.

Nu is the vibration of carrying.

With pah-nu we are carrying the Vast Self of Light, the Infinite, the Eternal Light that never stops.

When you repeat an action, it becomes you."

The cards help us to access the wisdom of the past, the present and the future, and to bring our personal vibration into harmony with the ever-moving energy of Life.

They truly seem to hold infinite wisdom, maybe that is because they are Artworks and are unlikely to become stuck in the form, whereas words can soon become cliches.

So, in this first session of 2024 it happened that 2 of the cards were placed side by side on the altar that is placed against the wall in the north-west of the Chamber.

I had often wondered why there were two Mother cards side by side and why they were placed in the Spring season. "So similar," was my casual thought, but despite quite a few years of working with the card pack there had never been a moment when insight came to me on this question, until this day as they lay side by side on the altar that is made of a section cut through a Scots Pine trunk showing all the growth rings.

We chanted, "Mother Earth – Mother Nature", and we sang their song, their songs. When I looked at the cards again, insights shone out of them with crystal clarity:

Mother Earth is the bedrock, the solid foundation of all that comes in time after her. Her eyes are closed, and her feet tell me where to look to find the Great Mystery of Mother Earth, in the Core of her Being. In each hand a plant in a pot grows upwards, absorbing the Sunlight, signalling the moment that enabled Life to become.

Mother Nature is the abundance of that becoming. On this card a tiny medicine bag floats unobtrusively in space and a child of innocence is born from the landscape, looking like a human child.

Mother Earth is the foundation of Life, and Mother Nature is the stream of creativity that is Life unfolding.

There is much, much more, to be inspired by on these cards, but what I drew from them on that chanting day was that Mother Nature is not here for me, and that Mother Earth is infinitely more steadfast and reliable than I am! Obvious conclusions, but never experienced before with such reality by me. And, on the upside, I am not separate from them, I am a part of them, I am them, and that is not a metaphor.

And then, in my metaphoric mind, I see that my more personal bedrock is formed by the Visions and Teachings of Beautiful Painted Arrow, Joseph Rael, and that my Mother Nature is living an inspiring life searching to realize Highest Potential for Life on this Planet.

I – This vowel is very soothing and she is very still, breathing deeply.



 O – Now she is in the Zen zone, chilled out and relaxed.



U – Sy doesn't snore, but this vowel carries her into full-body relaxation and sleep.



So, never underestimate the benefits of chanting for you and your pet. It relieves stress and anxiety, improves emotional well-being, can boost sleep quality and improve memory and focus.
